Kinzie is home to 782 students, 51% Hispanic, 48% White/Non-Hispanic, and 5% African American. Our school also has a large special education population, including a program for approximately 75 deaf students.

Kinzie students have always done well on standardized tests. However, students have shown significant growth in the areas of reading and math on the Scantron tests over the course of the 2011-2012 academic year. This year's growth on Scantron testing was particularly impressive, due in part to iPad implementation in the classrooms.
